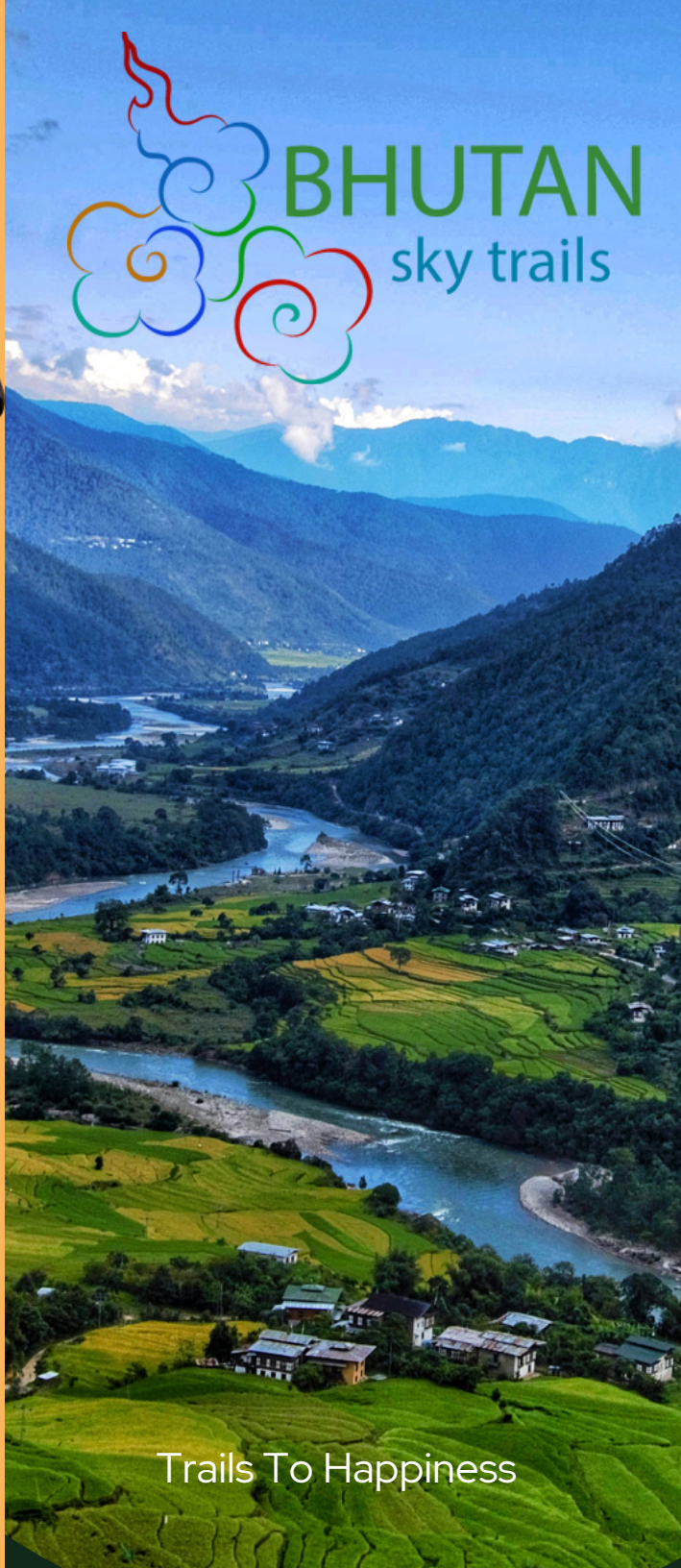

## ENTRY TO BHUTAN

Bhutan's main entry point is Paro International Airport in the Paro Valley. Visitors typically connect to Bhutan via major cities in neighboring countries, with layovers in cities like Bangkok, Singapore, Delhi, Kolkata, or Kathmandu. Druk Air and Bhutan Airlines operate regular flights to and from Paro, providing convenient access to the unique Himalayan kingdom.

The entry point to Bhutan by road is primarily through the land border with India. Phuentsholing, located in the southern part of Bhutan, serves as a key border town and the main entry point for overland travelers. Adjacent to the Indian town of Jaigaon in the state of West Bengal, Phuentsholing is connected by road to major Indian cities.



## Documentation for VISA

All visitors require a visa before traveling to Bhutan.

- A passport copy is required. The passport must be valid for six months from the intended departure date from the Kingdom.
- A recent passport-size photograph.
- Travel insurance, valid for the duration of the trip.
- The visa fee is USD 40 per person and it is non-refundable. While the process to issue the visa is usually quick, the visa can take up to five working days to process.



## SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT FEE (SDF)

Since the reopening on 23rd September 2022, visitors to Bhutan will make an active contribution to Bhutan's economic, social, and cultural development. The SDF enables investment in transformative programs that preserve our cultural traditions, protect our heritage and environment, upgrade infrastructure, create opportunities for our young people, and build resilience. SDF is USD 100 per night, per person and this fee does not cover the actual cost of Travel.
